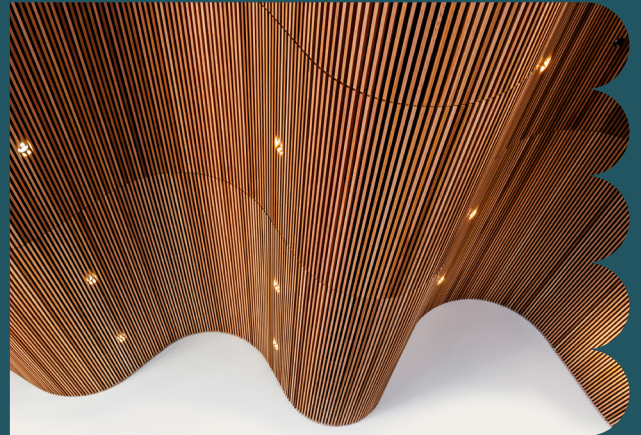


# Environment

### Certification

Screenwood is proud to hold Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC).

By obtaining certification, Screenwood is demonstrating that in choosing PEFC certified products, customers and consumers alike can make a valuable contribution to a sustainable environment. Screenwood's PEFC certified status offers assurances about sustainability in the entire value chain from the forest to the finished product. It complements other elements of Screenwood's philosophy and symbolizes the company's forward-looking engagement with timber from sustainable sources.

### Chain of Custody

Screenwood is committed to Chain of Custody to establish and maintain PEFC Certification.

Screenwood complies with AS 4707: 2014 Chain of Custody for certified wood and forest products and has a commitment to operating a Due Diligence System (DDS) in accordance with AS 4707:2014.

### VOC

PANELS have been VOC tested in accordance with ASTM D5116 small chamber test. At a result of 0.035mg/m<sup>2</sup>/hr, it exceeds the GBCA requirements for commercial fitouts.

### End of Use

All finishes for interior applications are water based and nontoxic, which allows for PANELS to be recycled at the end of their use. There are no adhesives used in the production of PANELS. They are mechanically joined to allow for maximum recyclability.

### Certification

Screenwood is proud to achieve Global Green Tag™ certification to Level B and the Platinum Level Health Rate.

Gaining recognised certification demonstrates our commitment to supply products of the utmost environmental integrity and provide a safe and sustainable environment throughout production to final use.

Green Tag accreditation provides assurance of several key areas such as health and safety, eco-toxicity, post-consumer recycled content, waste reduction, compliance with environmental and labour legislation, no heavy metals and low VOC content. This accreditation means that building owners and architects can utilise the GreenStar sustainability tool which is offered through the Green Building Council of Australia for their projects. They will have access to product credits through this scheme by utilising Decorative Fibreboard PANELS.

### VOC

Decorative Fibreboard PANELS have been tested in accordance with ASTM D5116-2017 small chamber test. Results for Group 3 products are below the limits specified by Green Building Council of Australia, Green Star Interiors requirements.
