Unlike wood veneers that require annual oiling, SOUNDLINA™ is easy to maintain. Simply wipe down any marks with a damp cloth for a quick clean.

Prefinished with NAVURBAN Diamond™ for durability

SOUNDLINA™ is prefinished with NAVURBAN Diamond™, an innovative decorative surface that uses Smart NANO™ Technology. It features a reinforced top layer, ensuring it retains its premium quality finish even in the toughest built environments. The surface's non-PVC olefin film is 3D-embossed with a textural woodgrain structure to evoke a beautiful natural aesthetic.

NAVURBAN Diamond™ provides an extra layer of surface protection and a seamless colour match to the range of prefinished Screenwood and NAV™ products. NAVURBAN Diamond™ finishes are UV stable and scratch, abrasion, stain and water resistant, ensuring longevity and durability.

How to clean SOUNDLINA™

During the installation process, it is important that any glue on the surface of the wallpaper is removed using a clean damp sponge.

Once installed, any dust or dirt can be cleaned simply by using a clean damp cloth with warm water and if needed a gentle detergent. Ensuring all excess water has been rung from the cloth (as this can interfere with the adhesive glue), wipe the wallpaper down in the direction of the woodgrain.

Chemicals to Avoid:

If in doubt about a particular cleaner or detergent, check with its manufacturer for the suitability. We recommend you test on a small area or sample prior to applying to the installed surface.

Avoid the use of acetone or trichloroethylene for cleaning purposes. Use of abrasive cleaners, powders, scouring pads, steel wool, sandpaper etc. can damage the finish and make the surface susceptible to staining.

Accidental spills or splatters from harsh materials should be wiped off immediately, and the area cleaned thoroughly with a damp cloth. Examples of these materials are:

- harsh detergents,
- chlorine bleach, and
- tub and tile cleaners

For ongoing care of SOUNDLINA™

SOUNDLINA™ has been designed for longevity and durability. To keep it looking its best, avoid dragging or knocking heavy objects against the surface. If a scratch or damage does occur, you can:

- order a repair patch from Screenwood, or
- reapply a panel of wallpaper.
