



This Panels range is available in Group 2 fireretardant medium-density fibreboard (FR MDF) and Group 3 moisture-resistant medium-density fibreboard (MR MDF).

SC15 acoustic textile (included)

Panels MR and FR systems are fitted with a highperformance SC15 acoustic textile to reduce reverberation and increase speech intelligibility in noise-sensitive environments. This acoustic fabric achieves an NRC of up to 0.7* and has been designed to complement this range.

SCP50 acoustic polyester (optional)


